Directions for Reading

- 1. Read the story

 - Ask questions (it is better to ask who, what, where when, and why than yes/no)
 - d) Let your child make comments and ask questions too

Sing songs that pertain to the subject matter. For example if you read If You Give a Moose a Muffin, sing the Muffin Man.
Complete a simple, creative art project. For example, after reading Rainbow Fish, cut out a fish pattern and have your child paint it and add his/her own sequins or cut up foil. Use it when you reread the story.
