# **Visual Schedule Information**

Through the eLearning process, you may find the need for more structure in accomplishing the eLearning activities. One thing that may help is using a visual schedule to allow children to see the school routine for the day. The following pages include materials that can be printed to create a visual schedule. Each page includes an arrow that can be cut out and moved along as activities are completed (that is how we use ours at school).

TYPICAL SCHEDULE (BOTH AM & PM VERSIONS): I am including this schedule for those that would like to add to the daily eLearning with activities that would be part of our daily routine. THIS IS NOT REQUIRED! Please do not feel the need to use this...I am including it for those families that feel that their child needs more than the daily eLearning activities. Here are tips for the additional activities.... Choice Time- Allow your child to choose a toy (blocks, puzzles, puppets, dolls, etc.). Set a timer for 20+ minutes and challenge the child to play with that toy until the timer goes off. The objective is to help the child with sustained engagement for an activity.

<u>Calendar-</u>On our website I will include resources that will help you work through parts of our calendar routine.

<u>Snack-</u> Encourage your child to ask with "May I have \_\_\_\_ please?" and to clean up after themselves when finished. This is what is required of them at school. <u>Play-</u> No rules! If it is good weather...get outside! If not, have fun playing inside! We will engage in playtime anywhere from 15 to 30 minutes!

**LARGE VERSION & ADDITIONAL CARDS:** These pieces are being included so that, if desired, you can cut out the individual cards and order them as needed for each day. I will often switch up our daily schedule by mixing the order of our cards, eliminating schedule pieces, etc... depending on what we have going on that day.

\*tip\*- Laminating items is key for us at school to make any paper tool last longer...a cheat way to laminate something is to put clear packing tape on either side of the paper and cut around it.








## **TYPICAL AM CLASS SCHEDULE**












